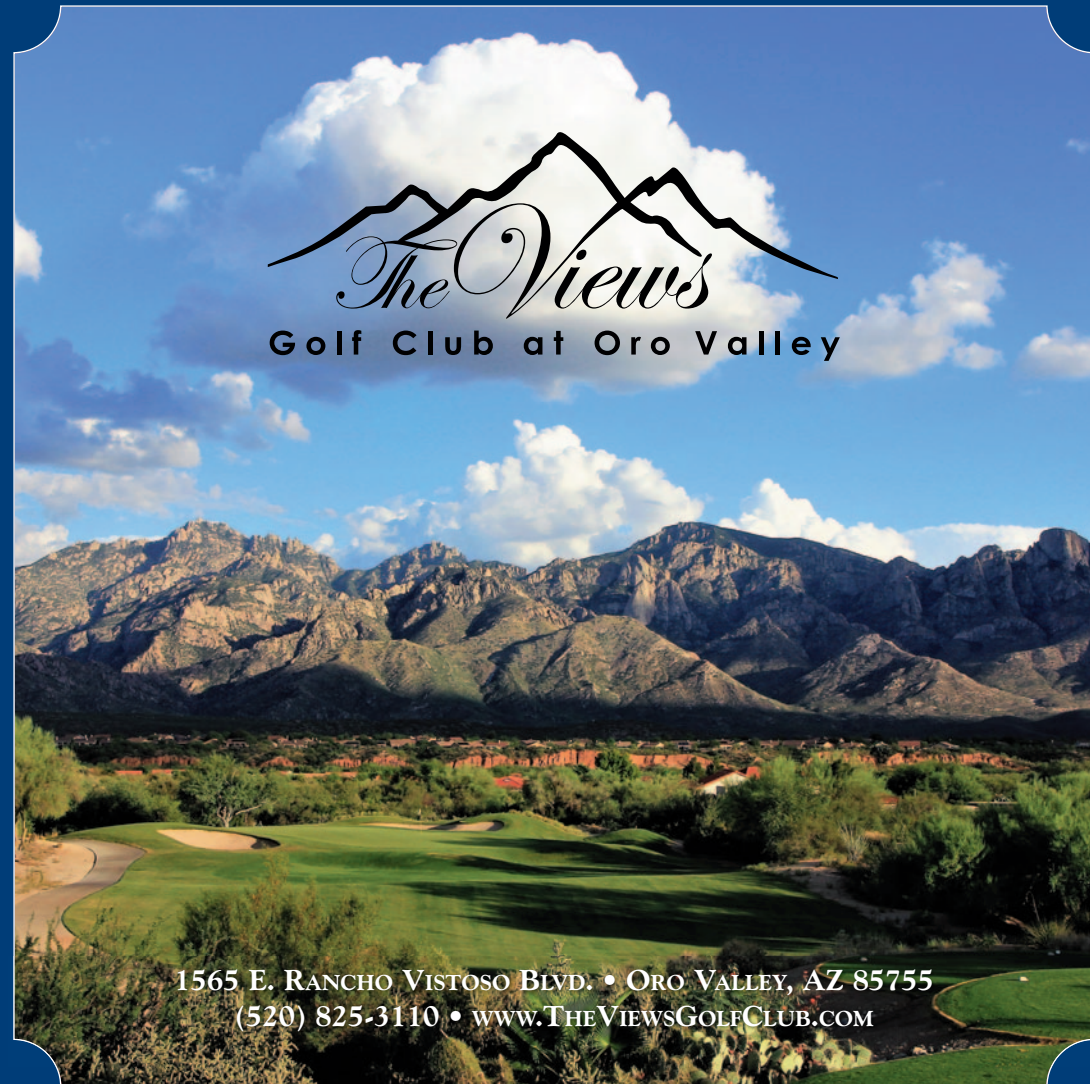


**COURSE ETIQUETTE & USGA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY
EXCEPT WHERE LOCAL RULES PREVAIL**

- **PLAY READY GOLF** - Please keep pace with the group in front. Slower groups may be asked to allow faster groups to play through or to skip a hole to catch up with the group in front of you. The pace of play is 4 hours for an 18-hole round. Compliance with our Player Assistant's is mandatory.
- Utilize 90-degree cart path rule or the Blue Gate System - carts must remain on the paths on par 3's and are not permitted behind or within 30 yards of any tee or green.
- Please repair ball marks on greens, fill divots, rake bunkers and place rakes in bunkers with the handle out.
- Appropriate golf attire and footwear required based on current golf fashion on practice facilities and golf course for all players.
- Out-of-bounds - Defined by white stakes, roads, boundary fences or private property. (Rule 18)
- Penalty Areas - Defined by red and yellow stakes and lines when present. (Rule 17)
- Optional ball drops are available for penalty areas located on #2, #7, #8, #9 & #15. Note: Wall/fence left of #15 green - relief may be taken in drop area, provided the ball is outside the penalty area and not touching the wall.
- Immovable Obstructions - Includes cement and asphalt paths. Arranged rock and white lined areas tying into paths have the same status as the paths, and thus they are obstructions and not ground under repair. (Rule 16-1) F-3
- Ground under repair - Areas defined by white lines (except ball drops) relief for sod seams is for the lie of ball or area of intended swing only. Relief is mandatory from all staked ground under repair areas.
- E-4 Relief from Aeration Holes
- E-5 Alternative to Stroke and Distance for Lost Ball or Ball Out-of-Bounds – When a player's ball has not been found or is known or virtually certain to be out-of-bounds, the player may proceed as follows rather than proceeding under stroke and distance. The point where the original ball is estimated to have come to rest on the course, or last crossed the edge of the course boundary to go out of bounds. Identify the nearest fairway edge – drop a ball within 2 club lengths from the fairway edge - no nearer the hole. Add 2 penalty strokes.
